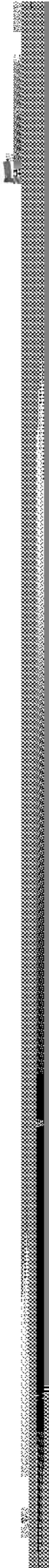




The process of a bill becoming a law involves several steps. It begins with a bill being introduced in either the House or the Senate. The bill then moves to a committee for review. After the committee's review, the bill goes to the floor for debate and a vote. If the bill passes in both the House and the Senate, it goes to the President. The President can sign the bill into law or veto it. If the President vetoes the bill, Congress can override the veto with a two-thirds majority in both chambers.

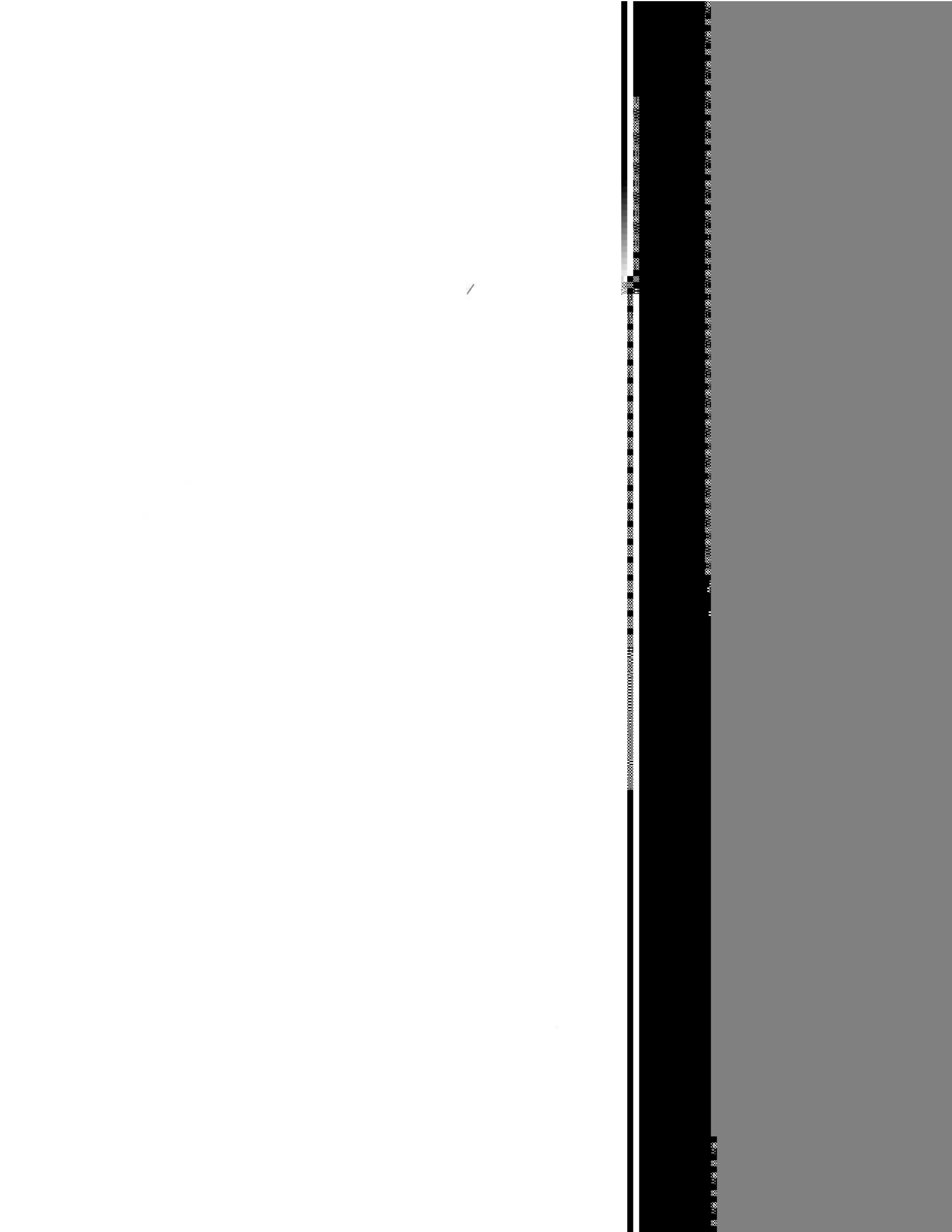

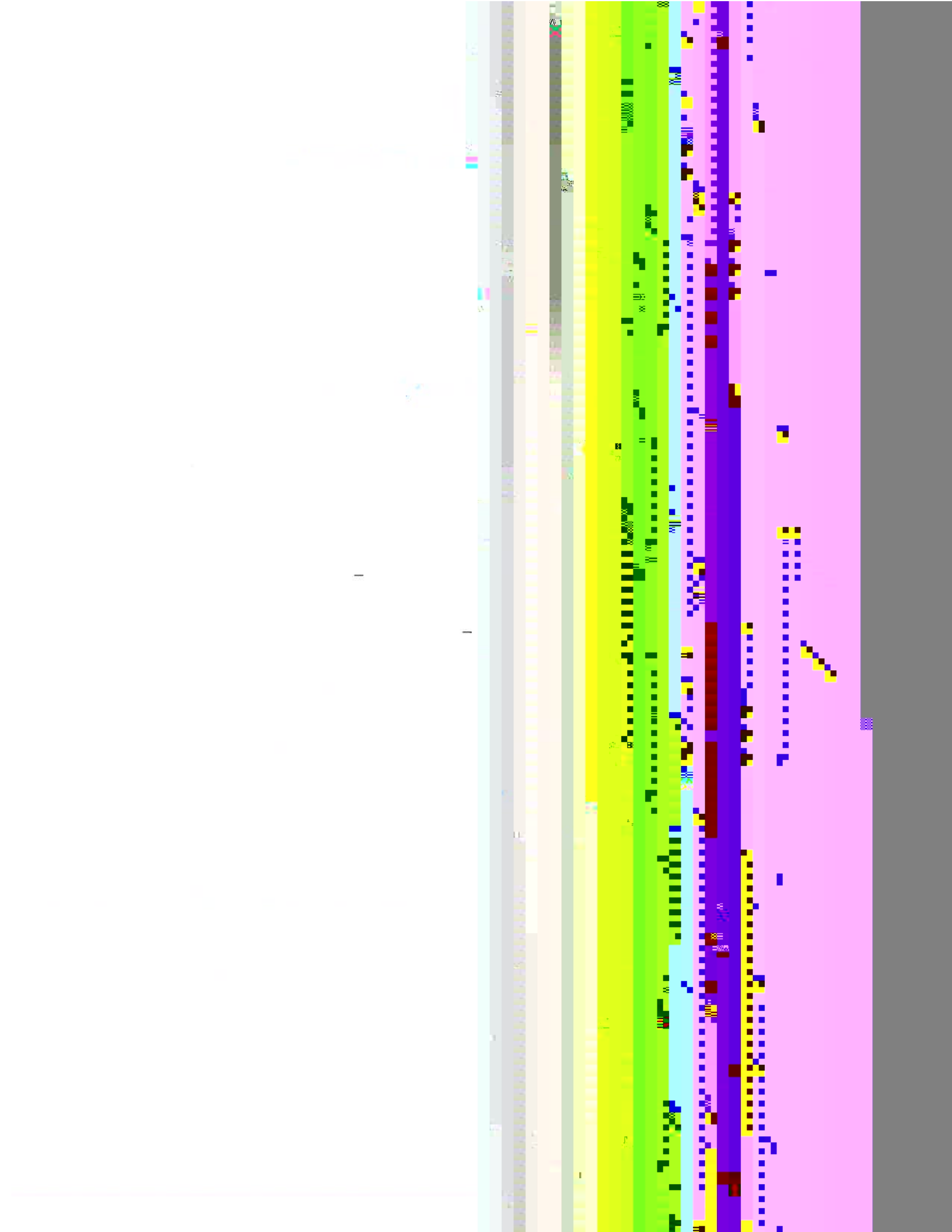
