

THE 2014–15 INFLUENZA SEASON HAS ARRIVED

A routine annual infuenza vaccination is recommended for all persons with sickle cell disease aged 6 months or older who do not have contraindications. \$ YDFFLQDWLRQ WR SUHYHQW LQÀXHQ]D is particularly important for persons who are at an LQFUHDVHG ULVN IRU VHYHUH FRPSOLFDWLRQV IURP LQÀX Adults and children with sickle cell disease who have chronic lung (including asthma), heart (except isolated high blood pressure), kidney, and liver conditions, along with diabetes, strokes, or loss of spleen function should UHFHLYH WKHLU ÀX YDFFLQH

Timing of Vaccination
